General delegations:	 To extend the general delegations under the Scheme to the following in addition to the existing delegations to the Managing Director and Director of Resources: The Director of Delivery, The Director of Transport Service, The Director of Policy Strategy and Communications, and

Table A – functions reserved to Combined Authority	 The Executive Head of Economic Services To update in respect of data protection compliance legislation, To make the compliance requirements more comprehensive by inserting specific reference to health and safety, risk management and equality and diversity. To update the list of policies and strategies to be reserved for approval by the Combined Authority (to be further updated from time to time as other policies and strategies are approved).
Managing Director (MD)	To clarify that the MD cannot exercise any function of another statutory officer.
Director of Resources	 To clarify the Director of Resources' role as Senior Risk Information Officer, and what this entails. To update the list of functions which fall to the Director of Resources, to reflect agreed practice, and clarify that strategic responsibility for these functions lies with this Director.
Head of Legal and Governance Services	To clarify that the delegation to amend documents in specific circumstances extends to any governance document.
