Following a procurement exercise, this decision is to award and enter into two contracts with the West Yorkshire Consortium of Colleges to deliver the sub-contracted provision related to the project. It is envisaged that the contracts will commence on 29 th April 2019 (following standstill) and terminate on 31 December 2021. The award will be made up of two Lots: • Contract/Lot 1 - Skills for the Digital Sector. This lot has a value of £1.5M. • Contract/Lot 2 - Skills for the Engineering and Construction Sector.
