


Appendix 2: Energy Performance Certificate analysis




Cleaned data shows a higher number of dwellings with an energy efficiency rating of C or above, in line with ONS figures, and Leeds' new dwellings closer to the remaining local authorities


Figure: Profile of New Energy Performance Certificates with energy efficiency rating of C or above by local authority and Energy Efficiency Rating, revised estimates

West Yorkshire dwellings with an EPC are less likely to have an energy efficiency rating of C or above compared to national average


