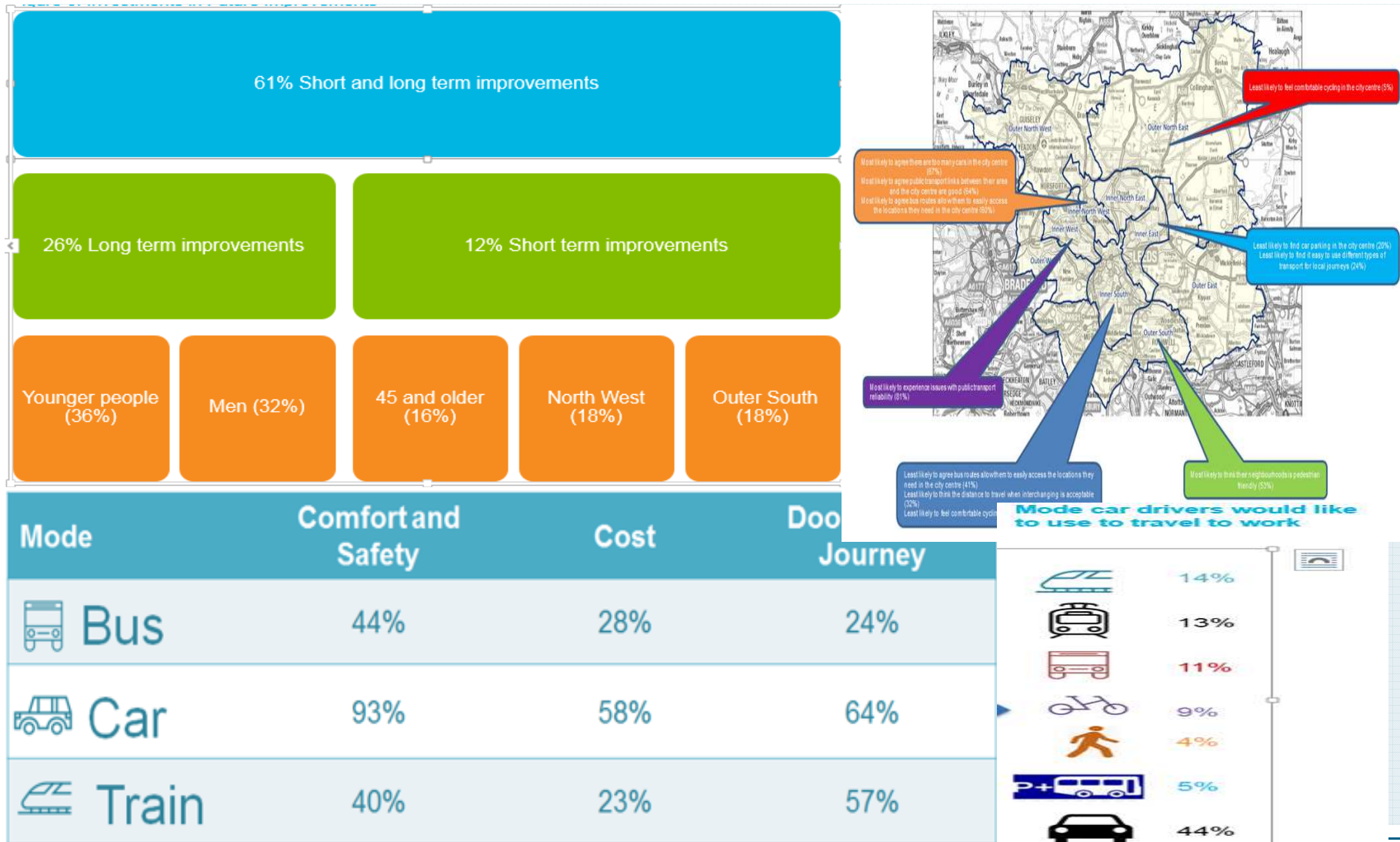

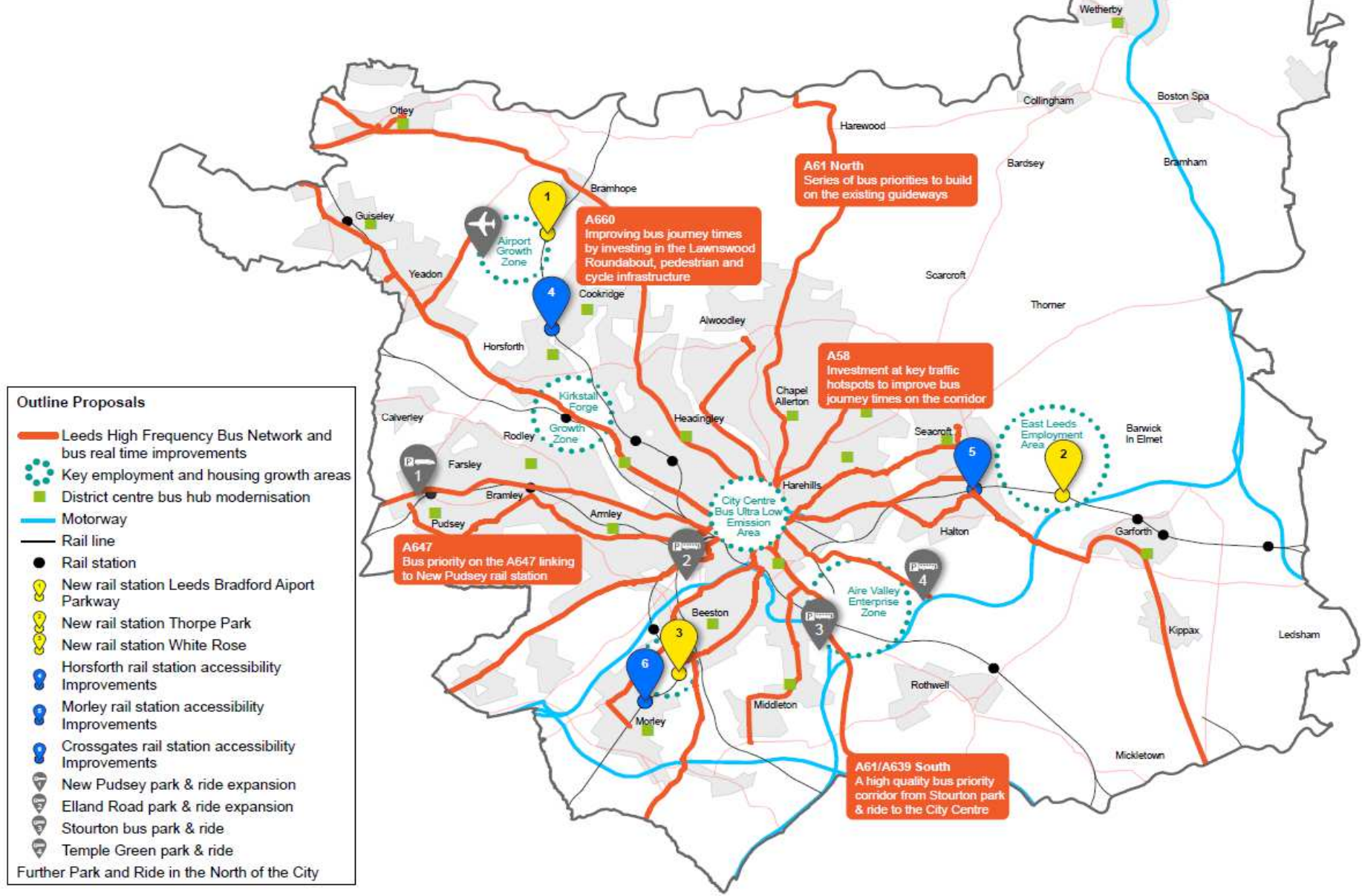

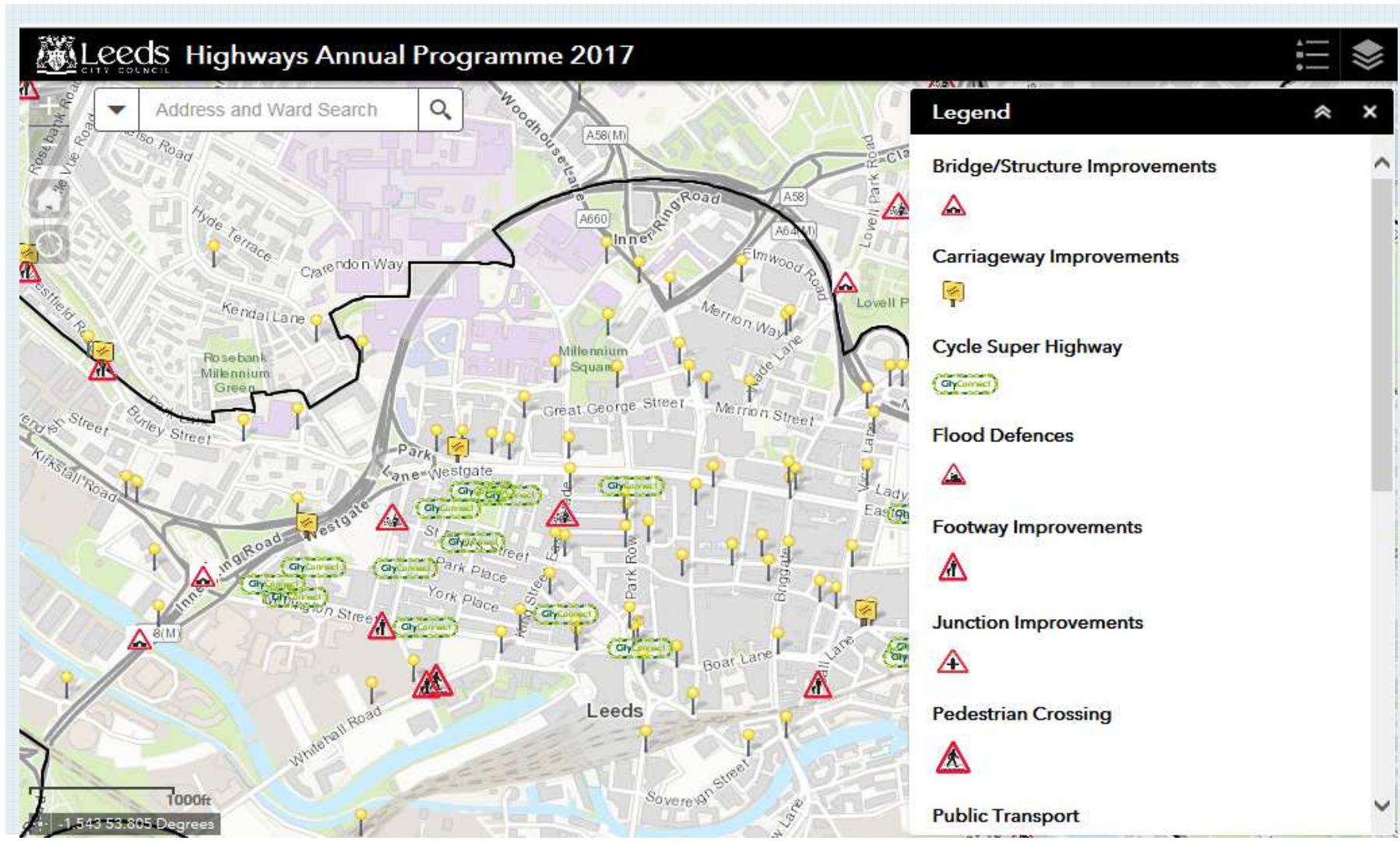

Partnership With Bus Operators

1. Joint pledge to double bus patronage in 10 years
2. £80m investment in new buses
3. Compliance with Clean Air Zone by 2020 (Euro 6) , phased plan to introduce clean fuel technologies
4. Up to date information, ticketing and payment
5. High frequency services to operate until 8pm weekdays

Transport Hubs and Connecting Communities

Project	Description	Funding
Transport Hubs	To deliver new or upgraded facilities, which will improve the waiting environment, travel information and interchange opportunities with other modes.	£8m
Connecting Communities	To improve the bus service offer either through dedicated services or supporting technologies. This will be delivered in communities where the commercial bus network does not operate to provide sufficient coverage.	£5m
